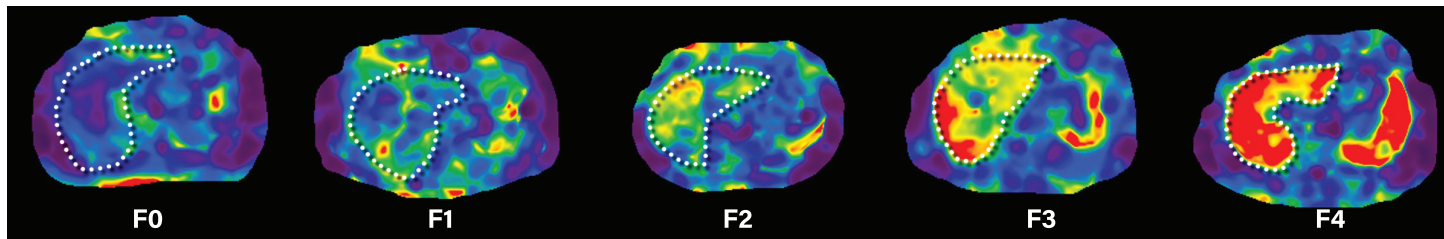


# Magnetic Resonance Elastography

- MRE is a revolutionary non-invasive imaging technique that quantitatively depicts the mechanical properties of tissue, such as liver stiffness.
- MRE was invented at Mayo Clinic and is FDA cleared. The procedure is covered by Medicare and most private payers.
- MRE can be ordered as a standalone exam that only takes 15 minutes, or it can be added to a full abdominal MRI workup. Clinicians can also request PDFF for liver fat assessment.
- MRE is recognized as a standard of care by the AGA, AASLD and ACR, and is considered a non-invasive alternative to liver biopsy.



Patients report that MRE exams are comfortable, with some patients describing the vibrations as “gentle.” The average MRE exam is also rapid, and is unaffected by common factors like high BMI.
